Guidelines for submission of abstracts:

Abstracts should be submitted on or before November 15, 2007 to The Secretariat at research@wvsu.edu.ph. Abstract must be in English (250-300 words) typed in MS-Word, 12 point, single spaced. The abstract shall include the title (14 point, bold, all caps, Times New Roman), Author/s (12 point, with the name of the presenting author underlined), institution, and contact information addresses with fax, e-mail (10 point, Arial).

A panel of Reviewers/Technical Experts will referee all paper or poster abstracts. Letter of acceptance/non-acceptance will be sent on or before December 15, 2007 thru e-mail.

The submission of full papers will be on or before January 15, 2008

Oral presentation should be in PowerPoint.

Guidelines for submission of posters:

A poster may be preliminary report of an ongoing research or completed research. It has to be done on 3 ft x 5 ft size tarpaulin.
